Smoke impacts due to the Point Fire, Woolsey Fire,
Lower Fire and the Skinner Complex



- These naturally ignited fires are being managed for natural resource benefits
- Smoke may settle into the Canyon in the evening and will lift out during the day as temperatures increase
- Visibility could be reduced during increased fire activity
