

ORDER
EMERGENCY FIRE CLOSURE
KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST
Williams Ranger District

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551, 36 CFR § 261.50(a), and 36 CFR § 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Kaibab National Forest, Coconino County within the state of Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibits A.

PROHIBITION:

1. Going into or being upon the restricted area; 36 CFR § 261.52(e).
2. Being on the road (36 CFR 261.54(e))

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Officer or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance on an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

Bounded by County Rd 73 (aka Perkinsville Rd) on the east; headed south along County RD 73 to FSR 122 (aka Twin Springs Rd); heading west along FSR 122 to FSR 108 (Bill Williams Mtn Loop Rd); moving along FSR 108 North to Interstate 40; headed east along I-40 to exit 161; headed east along old Route 66 to 12th St in Williams, AZ; headed south to Oak/McPherson Ave east to County Rd 73.

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to unexpected fire conditions.

This Order becomes effective at 11:30 AM, October 3, 2009, and will remain in force until rescinded or until November 3, 2009, whichever occurs first.
