



MARINA FIRE JUNE 27th, 2016

The Marina fire has remained at 658 acres and containment has increased to 46%. Firefighters on the ground along with both fixed-wing planes and especially helicopters are continuing to make progress on the containment line around the fire perimeter. Mop-up is continuing in the fire area, including along Highway 395. The California Highway Patrol continues to watch traffic travelling through this area. We ask that drivers continue to drive cautiously through the area, as fire crews are actively working along the roadway and Southern California Edison crews are repairing and replacing the power lines affected by the fire. Although k-rails (the modular cement fencing) have been placed along 395 through the fire area, rockslides and failing debris may still occur in the road. Drive carefully to take care of yourself and to keep our firefighters safe.. The fire has been determined to be human-caused and remains under investigation.
