

ORDER NO. 14-05-743
KLAMATH NATIONAL FOREST
EMERGENCY CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Klamath National Forest. This Order is effective from August 5, 2014, until the Beaver Complex Fire is declared out.

1. Being on Beaver Creek Road (Forest Road No. 11) from its beginning at County Road 8J01 to its junction with Beaver Trap Road (Forest Road No. 48N25), as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
2. Going into or being upon Beaver Creek Campground, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.53(e).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Executed in Yreka, California, this 4th day of August, 2014.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
