

ORDER NO. 14-05-757
KLAMATH NATIONAL FOREST
EMERGENCY CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Klamath National Forest. This Order is effective from September 6, 2014, until the Beaver Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Beaver Fire Closure Area. The boundary of the Beaver Fire Closure Area begins at the intersection of Highway 96 and Empire Creek Road (Forest Road No. 47N24); then continues west along the northern edge of Highway 96 to its intersection with Bar Road (County Road No. SIS-8F003); then continues northwest along the northeastern boundary of Bar Road (County Road No. SIS-8F003) to its intersection with Doggett Middle Road (Forest Road No. 12); then continues north along the eastern edge of Doggett Middle Road (Forest Road No. 12) to its intersection with Middle Horse Creek Road (Forest Road No. 47N63); then continues north along the eastern edge of Middle Horse Creek Road (Forest Road No. 47N63) to its intersection with North Boundary Road (Forest Road No. 47N81); then continues east along the southeastern edge of North Boundary Road (Forest Road No. 47N81) to its intersection with Siskiyou Summit Road (Forest Road No. 40S01); then continues northeast along the eastern edge of Siskiyou Summit Road (Forest Road No. 40S01) to its intersection with the Pacific Crest Trail (Forest Trail No. 2000); then continues northeast along the eastern edge of the Pacific Crest Trail (Forest Trail No. 2000) to its intersection with Siskiyou Summit Road (Forest Road No. 40S01); then continues northeast along the southeastern edge of Siskiyou Summit Road (Forest Road No. 40S01) to its intersection with West Beaver Road (Forest Road No. 47N01); then continues southeast along the southwestern edge of the West Beaver Road (Forest Road No. 47N01) to its intersection with Beaver Creek Road (Forest Road No. 11); then continues east and then south along the southern and then western edge of Beaver Creek Road (Forest Road No. 11) to its intersection with Bullion Mountain Road (Forest Road No. 48N05); then continues south along the western boundary of Bullion Mountain Road (Forest Road No. 48N05) to its intersection with Shaft Rock Road (Forest Road No. 47N21); then continues southeast along the southwestern boundary of Shaft Rock Road (Forest Road No. 47N21) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 47N21B; then continues southwest along the north edge of Forest Road No. 47N21B to its intersection with private property; then continues due south to its intersection with Empire Creek Road (Forest Road No. 47N24); then continues south along the western boundary of Empire Creek Road (Forest Road No. 47N24) back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e).

2. Being on any National Forest System road in the Beaver Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the Beaver Fire Closure Area to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.


