**EMERGENCY CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within Oak Knoll District of the Klamath National Forest and the Siskiyou Mountains District of the Rogue River Siskiyou National Forest. This Order is effective from August 31, 2016, until the Gap Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Gap Fire Closure Area. The Gap Fire Closure Area boundary begins at the intersection of Highway 96 and the Pacific Crest Trail (Forest Trail No. 2000); then continues northerly and then easterly along the western edge and then northern edge of the Pacific Crest Trail (Forest Trail No. 2000) to its intersection with West Beaver Road (Forest Road No. 47N01); then continues southeast along the northeastern edge of West Beaver Road (Forest Road No. 47N01) to its intersection with Beaver Creek Road (Forest Road No. 11); then continues southeast along the northeastern edge of Beaver Creek Road (Forest Road No. 11) to its intersection with Beaver Creek Road (County Road No. SIS-8J07); then continues southerly along the western edge of Beaver Creek Road (County Road No. SIS-8J07) to its intersection with Highway 96; then continues westerly along the northern edge of Highway 96 back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map.

2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Gap Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Gap Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
