

ORDER NO. 13-11

**SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
WESTERN DIVIDE RANGER DISTRICT
FISH FIRE
CLOSURE AREA**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Western Divide Ranger District of the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective August 25, 2013, until the Fish Fire has been fully suppressed.

1. Going into or being upon the Fish Fire Closure Area. The Fish Fire Closure Area starts at the intersection of the Kern River and the Sequoia National Forest boundary in Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then south along the Kern River to its intersection with the Kern Flat Trail (Forest Trail No. 33E20) in Section 1, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then south along the Kern Flat Trail to its intersection with the Doe Meadow Trail (Forest Trail No. 33E10) near Kern Flat in Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then west to along Doe Meadow Trail to its intersection with the southern boundary of Section 8, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then west along the section line to the southwest corner of Section 8, then north along the section line to its intersection with the Lewis Camp Trail (Forest Trail No. 33E01), then west along the Lewis Camp Trail to its intersection with the Little Kern River in Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then northwest along the Little Kern River to its intersection with Round Meadow Trail (Forest Trail No. 32E14) in Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then north and east along the Round Meadow Trail to its intersection with the Lion Meadow Trail (Forest Trail No. 32E02) in Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then west and north along the Lion Meadow Trail to its intersection with the Coyote Lakes Trail (Forest Trail No. 32E05) at Lion Meadow in Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then north and east along the Coyote Lakes Trail to its intersection with the Sequoia National Forest boundary in Section 36, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then north along the Sequoia National Forest boundary to the starting point, as shown on the attached map.

CFR 261.52(e).

2. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Fish Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the Fish Fire Closure Area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.


