

ORDER NO. 15-22

**SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
GIANT SEQUOIA NATIONAL MONUMENT
WESTERN DIVIDE RANGER DISTRICT**

CABIN FIRE AREA CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Western Divide Ranger District of the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective from September 2, 2015, until the Cabin Fire has been fully suppressed.

1. Going into or being upon the Cabin Fire Closure Area. The boundary of the Cabin Fire Closure Area starts at the intersection of the Quinn Trail (Forest Trail No. 31E13) and the northern Golden Trout Wilderness boundary in Section 26, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues north along the east side of Quinn Trail to its intersection with Little Kern Trail (Forest Trail No. 31E12) in Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues southeast along the south side of the Little Kern Trail to its intersection with the Lion Meadow Trail (Forest Trail No. 32E02) in Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues south along the west side of the Lion Meadow Trail to its intersection with Clicks Creek Trail (Forest Trail No. 32E11) in Section 28, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues southwest along the west side of Clicks Creek Trail to its intersection with the Golden Trout Wilderness boundary in Section 18, Township 20 South, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues northwest along the Golden Trout Wilderness boundary to Maggie Mountain in Section 21, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues north along the Windy Ridge the Sequoia National Forest boundary in Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues east and north along the forest boundary back to the starting point, as shown on the attached Map.
2. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Cabin Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached Map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.
16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.


