

ORDER NO. 10-15-08
SIX RIVERS NATIONAL FOREST
EMERGENCY CLOSURE



Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Gasquet Ranger District of the Six Rivers National Forest. This Order is effective from September 10, 2015, until the Gasquet Fire Complex is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Gasquet Fire Complex Closure Areas, as described below and shown on Exhibits 1, 2 and 3.
 - a. The boundary of the Gasquet Fire Complex Bear Closure Area begins at the intersection of Forest Road No. 199 and the northwest corner of Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 3 East, Humboldt Base and Meridian (HBM), then continues east along Forest Road No. 199 to its intersection with Section 5, Township 17 North, Range 4 East, HBM, then continues due east to its intersection with the northern edge of Forest Road No. 17N30, then continues east along the northern edge of Forest Road No. 17N30 to its intersection with the northern edge of Forest Road No. 18N08F, then continues east along the northern edge of Forest Road No. 18N08F to its intersection with the terminus of Forest Road No. 18N08F, then continues west along the southern edge of Forest Road No. 18N08F to its intersection with Forest Road No. 18N08, then continues east along the northern edge of Forest Road No. 18N08 to its intersection with the Siskiyou Wilderness boundary, then continues east along the Siskiyou Wilderness boundary to its intersection with the Middle Fork Smith River, then continues north along the Middle Fork Smith River to its intersection with the southern boundary of Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 5 East, HBM, then continues east along the northern boundaries of Sections 7 and 8, to its intersection with the western edge of Youngs Valley Trail, then continues north along the western edge of Youngs Valley Trail to its intersection with the western edge of Forest Road No. 18N02, then continues northwest along the western edge of Forest Road No. 18N02 to its intersection with Section 32, Township 18 North, Range 5 East, HBM, then continues due east to its intersection with the Six Rivers National Forest boundary, then continues south along the Six Rivers National Forest boundary to its intersection with Section 24, Township 16 North, Range 4 East, HBM, then continues south along the eastern edge of Section 24 to its intersection with the northeast corner of Section 25, then continues due west along the northern edge of Section 25 to its intersection with the Island Lake Trail, then continues northwest along the western edge of Island Lake Trail to its intersection with Section 14, then continues due west to its intersection with Forest Road No. 16N02, then continues northwest along the southern edge of Forest Road No. 16N02 to its intersection with the southern edge of Forest Road No. 16N03, then continues northwest along the southern edge of Forest Road No. 16N03 to its intersection with the western edge of Forest Road No. 16N33, then continues north along the western edge of Forest Road No. 16N33 to the intersection with the southern edge of Forest Road No. 16N31B, then continues west along the southern edge of Forest Road No. 16N31B to its intersection with the western edge of Forest Road No. 17N08, then continues north along the western edge of Forest Road No. 17N08 to its intersection with the Six

Rivers National Forest boundary, then continues northeast along the Six Rivers National Forest boundary to its intersection with Section 12, Township 17 North, Range 3 East, HBM, then continues west along the southern edge of Section 12 to its intersection with the southeast corner of Section 11, then continues north along the eastern edge of Section 11 to its intersection with the southern edge of Forest Road No. 199, then continues northeast along Forest Road No. 199 back to the starting point, as shown on Exhibit 1.

- b. The boundary of the Gasquet Fire Complex Coon Closure Area begins at the intersection of Forest Road No. 17N07, Forest Road No. 411 and Forest Road No. 405, then continues south along the western edge of Forest Road No. 405 to its intersection with Gordon Creek, then continues southwest along the western edge of Gordon Creek to its intersection with the South Fork Smith River, then continues northwest along the eastern edge of the South Fork Smith River to its intersection with Craig's Creek, then continues northeast along the southern edge of Craig's Creek, back to the starting point, as shown on Exhibit 2.
- c. The boundary of the Gasquet Fire Complex G-O Closure Area begins at the intersection of Forest Road No. 15 (the "G-O Road") and the south side of the bridge crossing the South Fork of the Smith River, then continues east along the south side of the South Fork of the Smith River to its intersection with Eightmile Creek, then continues southeast along the east side of Eightmile creek to its intersection with the Gasquet Ranger District boundary, then continues southwest along the Gasquet Ranger District boundary to its intersection with Tributary D, then continues west along the south side of Tributary D to its intersection with Forest Road No. 14N01, then continues northwest along the southwest side of Forest Road No. 14N01 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 14N15 and Forest Road No. 15N13, then continues north along the west side of Forest Road No. 15N13 to its intersection with the Gasquet Ranger District boundary, then continues north along the Gasquet Ranger District boundary to its intersection with Forest Road No. 15N02, then continues north along the east side of Forest Road No. 15N02 to a point 1 mile northeast of its intersection with Forest Road No. 16N23, then continues due east back to the starting point, as shown on Exhibit 3.

2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Gasquet Fire Complex Closure Areas, as shown on Exhibit Nos. 1, 2, and 3. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Gasquet Fire Complex Closure Areas, as shown on Exhibit Nos. 1, 2, and 3. 36 CFR 261.55(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.


