AREA CLOSURE
Rough Fire – Version #1
For Public Safety

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on all lands as described in this order, within the Lowman District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until rescinded.

1. Going into or being upon the area as described in this order. **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The Rough Fire Closure Area is described as all National Forest System (NFS) lands (including all roads and trails within the area) within the following boundary - beginning at the Junction of NFS Road #515 (Red Mountain Trailhead Road) and NFS Road 582 (Clear Creek Road) located in Township 10 North, Range 8 East, Section 16; continuing northerly along, **and including** NFS Road #582 to Clear Creek Summit where the road becomes County Road (CR) #582; continuing northeasterly along, **but not including**, CR #582 to CR #579 (Bear Valley Road) located in Township 12 North, Range 9 East, Section 2; continuing easterly approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ miles along, **but not including** CR #579 to NFS Road #579C1 (Wyoming Creek Trailhead Road) located in Township 13 North, Range 9 East, Section 35; continuing southerly along, **and including** NFS Road ##579C1 to NFS Trail #015 (Wyoming Creek Trail) located in Township 12 North, Range 9 East, Section 2; continuing southerly along, **and including**, NFS Trail #015 to NFS Trail #016 (Gates Creek Trail) located in Township 12 North, Range 9 East, Section 24; continuing southeasterly along, **and including**, NFS Trail #016 to NFS Trail #144 (Pass Creek Trail) located in Township 11 North, Range 10 East, Section 8; continuing southwesterly along,

and including, NFS Trail #144 to NFS Trail #145 (Red Mountain Trail) located in Township 11 North, Range 9 East, Section 33; continuing westerly along **and including**, NFS Trail #145 to NFS Road #515 (At Red Mountain Trailhead) located in Township 10 North, Range 8 East, Section 1; continuing southwesterly along, **and including**, NFS Road #515 back to the point of origin.

The above described Area (including all roads and trails within the Area) are located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Lowman Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise County and Valley County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE:

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Rough Fire). This area is closed for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until Rescinded.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
4. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads, trails) covered by this Order.
