**Black Fire
Emergency Area, Road, and Trail Closure**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited in the area and on the roads and trails described in this Order, all within the Palisades Ranger District, Caribou-Targhee National Forest, until further notice:

1. Going into or being upon the area described below, which is closed for the protection of public health or safety. **36 CFR 261.53(e)**
2. Being on a trail described below that is posted as closed. **36 CFR 261.55(a)**
3. Being on a road described below that is posted as closed. **36 CFR 261.54(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons using FS Trails 067, 080 and 079, which remain open.

AREA, ROADS AND TRAILS DESCRIBED:

The area depicted on the attached map is closed to all entry, and is more particularly described as the area bounded by heading east starting at the Fullmer Boat Ramp along and including FS road 206 (South Fork Snake River Road) past the BLM Warm Springs Recreation Site to the junction of the FS trail 155 (Rim Trail), including the trail, to FS trail 080 (Dry Canyon), then extending north along the Dry Canyon watershed divide to Black Mountain, continue north along the watershed divide between Blacks Canyon and West Pine Creek, continue to Chicken Peak following north along FS trail 079, (but not including the trail), to Liar's Pass, continue northeast along the FS trail 079 (but not including the trail), to the hydrologic divide following that divide to Piney Peak, continuing north along the divide to the headwaters of Burns Creek, continue west down Burns Creek to the confluence of Burns Creek and the outflow of Castle Lake, then extend northwest along the ridge to Temple Peak, follow the ridge to the intersection of FS trail 077 (Thousand Springs), continue northwest along FS trail 077 (including the trail) to the intersection of FS trail 067, continue southwest along FS trail 067 (but not including the trail), to the intersection of FS trail 121 (Prospect Peak), continue southwest to the hydrologic divide between Burns Canyon and Kelly Canyon, following the hydrologic divide to the southwest to the end of

FS road 213 (Hinkley Road), continue west along FS road 213 (including the road), to the intersection of FS trail 070 (Hells Hole), continue south along the hydrologic divide to peak 7669, continue southeast along the hydrologic divide between Burns Canyon and Woods Canyon to the headwaters of Woods Creek, continue downstream to the intersection of FS road 206, continuing west to Fullmer Boat Ramp.

FS trails 155, 064, 068, 070, 071, 073, 074, 077, 121, 291 and 287 (Ranger Trail southeast of Burns Creek) are closed.

FS roads 206, 210 and 213 (Hinkley Road is closed from Kelly Canyon.) are closed.

The above described area and trails are within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the Palisades Ranger District, Caribou-Targhee National Forest, Bonneville County, ID.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this order is to protect public safety in the presence of an active fire in the area.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect through September 30, 2016 or until terminated, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals, and \$10,000.00 for organizations and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.




