AREA CLOSURE
Summit Fire – Version #1
For Public Safety

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on all lands as described in this order, within the Idaho City and Lowman Ranger Districts, Boise National Forest. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the area as described in this order. **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The Summit Fire Closure Area is described as all National Forest System (NFS) lands (including all roads and trails within the area) beginning at NFS Road 380, located in Township 7 North, Range 7 East, Section 18, continuing Northwest along NFS Road 380 to the intersection of the Lowman/Idaho City Ranger Districts boundary line, located in Township 7 North, Range 6 East, Section 1, then following the Lowman/Idaho City District Boundary heading Northeast to the intersection with Highway 21, located in Township 8 North, Range 7 East, Section 15, and continuing Northeast along Highway 21 (but not including Highway 21) to the intersection with NFS Road 594, located in Township 9 North, Range 7 East, Section 34, continuing South along NFS Road 594 to the section line between Township 9 North, Range 7 East, Section 33 and Township 8 North, Range 7 East, Section 4, and continuing west along the section line to Burns Ridge (Lowman/Emmett Ranger District boundary line), located in Township 8 North, Range 7 East, Section 5, and continuing Southwest along the district boundary to the intersection with the NFS Road 380D, located in Township 8 North, Range 6 East, Section 24, continuing Southwest along NFS Road 380D to the intersection with NFS Road 380, located in Township 8 North, Range 6 East, Section 23, continuing Northwest along NFS Road 380 to the intersection with

NFS Road 397, located in Township 8 North, Range 6 East, Section 23, continuing Northwest along NFS Road 397 to the intersection with the section line located between Township 8 North, Range 6 East, Section 7 and Township 8 North, Range 5 East, Section 12, and continuing south along the western section boundary line of Sections 18, 19, 30, 31, 6, 7, and 18, located in Township 8 North, Range 6 East, continuing East along the southern section line of Sections 18, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13 in Township 8 North, Range 6 East, and continuing East along the southern Section line of Section 18, in Township 8 North, Range 7 East to the intersection with NFS Road 380, as depicted on attached map.

The above described Area (including all roads and trails within the area) are located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Idaho City and Lowman Ranger Districts, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE:

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Summit Fire). This area is closed for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
4. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads, trails) covered by this Order.
5.
