**ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(a)&(b) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service Roads and Trails, as shown on the attached maps, within the Salmon River District of the Nez Perce-Clearwater National Forests. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **immediately** and will remain in effect until rescinded.

1. **When provided in an order, it is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. Title 36 CFR 261.53 (e)**
2. **Being on the Road. Title 36 CFR 261.54(e)**
3. **Being on the Trail. Title 36 CFR 261.55(a)**

**Area Closure – Gun Club Fire**

Area Defined within: Commencing at the intersection of Road 1614 and Road 221 north to the intersection of Road 263. Follow Road 263 west to the intersection with Road 2007. Follow Road 2007 north to Trail 118. Follow Trail 118 north to intersection with Trail 136. Follow Trail 136 west to the intersection with Trail 82. Follow Trail 82 west to the intersection with Road 263. Follow Road 263 west to intersection Salmon River District Boundary. Follow Salmon River District Boundary south to road 1614. Follow Road 1614 east to road 221.


<b>Note:</b> Salmon River Road 1614 - OPEN	Trail 118 portions CLOSED
Grangeville-Salmon Road 221 - OPEN	Trail 136 portions CLOSED
Road 263 CLOSED	Trail 82 CLOSED

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty. Report all emergency access to the Salmon River District Ranger as soon as possible.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**RATIONALE:** These restrictions are promulgated for **PUBLIC HEALTH and SAFETY** due to the Gun Club Fire.

**PENALTY:** Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)

**NOTIFICATION:** A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office, each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
