AREA CLOSURES
Rapid Fire
(For Public Safety)

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b) the following act is prohibited on the lands described in this order, all within the administrative boundaries of the McCall Ranger District, Krassel Ranger District, Payette National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the area (as described in this order). **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

Rapid Fire Area (including all roads and trails within the area) is described as beginning at the intersection of National Forest System (NFS) Road #388 and the Payette National Forest Boundary, located on the Western boundary of Section 23, Township 17 North, Range 4 East; Continuing approximately 6 miles North along the Payette National Forest Boundary to the North West corner of section 27, Township 18 North, Range 4 East; Continuing North East to Boulder Mountain, located in Section 23, Township 18 North, Range 4 East; Continuing East to the junction of NFS Trail #096, and NFS Trail #097, located in the North East corner of Section 22, Township 18 North, Range 5 East; Continuing South East to the junction of NFS Trail #097, and NFS Trail #098 (Aspen Flat), located in the middle of Section 36, Township 18 North, Range 5 East; Continuing South to the junction of NFS Trail #100 and NFS Trail #098 (Cougar Creek Summit), located in the middle of Section 13, Township 18 North, Range 5 East; Continuing South West along and including NFS Trail #099 to Kennelly Creek Trailhead, located in the Middle of Section 29, Township 17 North, Range 5 East; Continuing West along and including NFS Road #388 to the Payette National Forest Boundary located on the Western Boundary of Section 23, Township 17 North, Range 3 East.

The above described area (including all roads and trails within the area) is located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Krassel Ranger

District, and McCall Ranger District, Payette National Forest, Valley County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE:

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Rapid Fire). This area (including all roads and trails within the area) is closed to all public access for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
4. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order on the roads and trails covered by this order.
