AREA CLOSURE
Zone 1 Beaver Creek Fire – Version #1
For public safety

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on all lands as described in this order, all within the Fairfield Ranger District, Sawtooth National Forest. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the area as described in this order. **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Persons on National Forest System Roads #085 and #087 and within Canyon Campground

AREA DESCRIBED:

Zone 1 Beaver Creek Fire Area is described as: all National Forest System (NFS) Lands (including all roads and trails within the area, but excluding all roads and trails along the boundary of the closure area) beginning at the intersection of the Sawtooth National Forest boundary and Forest Road #094, located at Township 2 North, Range 14 East, Section 29; continuing Northerly along (but excluding) Forest Road #094 to Forest Road #227, located at Township 3 North, Range 14 East, Section 32; continuing Northwesterly along (but excluding) Forest Road #227 to Forest Road #012, located at Township 3 North, Range 13 East, Section 11; continuing Northwesterly along (but excluding) Forest Road #012 to Forest Road #079, located at Township 4 North, Range 13 East, Section 34; continuing Northerly along (but excluding) Forest Road #079 to NFS Trail 888, located at Township 5 North, Range 13 East, Section 34; continuing Northerly along (but excluding) NFS Trail #888 to NFS Trail #063, located at Township 5 North, Range 13 East, Section 21; continuing Northeasterly along (but excluding) NFS Trail #063 to the Sawtooth National Recreation Area Boundary, located at Township 5 North, Range 14 East, Section 6; continuing Easterly, becoming Southerly along the Fairfield Ranger District Boundary to the Bureau of Land Management boundary, located on the Section

23 and 26 line of Township 2 North, Range 16 East; continuing Westerly along the Sawtooth National Forest Boundary back to the point of origin.

The above described area (including all roads and trails within the area) is located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Fairfield Ranger District, Sawtooth National Forest, Camas County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE:

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Zone 1 Beaver Creek fire). The area is closed to provide for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581(b)(7).
4. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the area (and/or roads, trails) covered by this order.
