### FAQs – What is an ICP? Where is it located? What is the mailing address?

**ICP** is an acronym for **Incident Command Post**, commonly called **Fire Camp**.

**This is generally the location where firefighters “live”** when they are not working on the fireline during the day (or night.) ICP is also the **location of the Incident Management Team (IMT)** assigned to the fire (or incident) who oversee the implementation of the Incident Objectives, like those listed in the Summary Section of the Main Page.

ICP becomes the **“home away from home”** and **“office space”** for firefighters.

**LOCATION:** Skyland ICP is located at the Glacier Meadows Campground east of Kalispell, MT on Highway 2E at about highway mile post 192.

This is approximately 75 miles east of Kalispell, MT; 15 miles from Essex, MT or approximately 20 miles west of East Glacier, MT.

**MAILING ADDRESS:** Skyland Fire Camp; General Delivery; East Glacier, MT 59434

This address is being used by firefighters to receive items while assigned to the Skyland Incident and stationed at the Skyland ICP. Mail must include their **NAME, POSITION & ORGANIZATION**. Skyland Fire Information Officers make regular trips around the local area delivering maps, news releases, and other information to key locations and organizations. During these trips, as a support service to the firefighters, they drop off and pick up letters and small packages for the incident firefighters. This is a key link between firefighters and their friends and family back home.
