How Did Skyland Fire Get Its Name?

The fire was named after Skyland Road.

Usually, when a fire is first identified, a number is assigned. It is only if the fire moves beyond the initial attack phase, that the incident commander assigned gives the fire its name.

Fires are often named for geographic features found in the surrounding area. While this is not always the case, they are frequently named after a nearby creek, river, trail, mountain or road.
