**CUSTER NATIONAL FOREST
BEARTOOTH RANGER DISTRICT
AREA CLOSURE**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50 (a) and (b) the following restrictions are in effect on the Beartooth Ranger District, Custer National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and become effective 1:00 p.m. Mountain Daylight Time August 13, 2006 when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded.

36 CFR 261.52 – FIRE

All persons are prohibited from going into or being upon National Forest Service System Lands within the area described below, Title 36 CFR 261.52 (e):


Beginning on the Custer National Forest boundary in Section 36, T3S, R14E (Lodge Pole Creek Trail) going south and east following the Lodge Pole Creek Trail to the Custer Forest boundary then south along the Forest boundary to the Stillwater River Highway #419 south to the Woodbine trailhead then south along the Stillwater River Trail #24 to the Lake Abundance Trailhead then north following the Custer and Gallatin National Forest boundary connecting to the point of origin. Not including private property (see attached map).

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit issued by a Forest Officer specifically authorizing prohibitive act;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fighting force in the performance of an official duty.



Violations of these Prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. [16 U.S.C. 551, and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571]
