**FOREST SUPERVISOR'S ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited as described below within the Ninemile Ranger District of the Lolo National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and become effective July 26, 2013 and will remain in effect until rescinded.

**36 CFR 261.54– National forest System roads**

**Description of road:** Black Cat Gulch Road Number 5465, Black Cat One Road Number 17426; Black Cat Four Road Number 17429, starting in Section 25.T.15N.,R.21W.

**It is prohibited to go into the area. (36 CFR 261.53 e).**

The closure cited in this order is for emergency resource protection and to protect public users from potential harm during the Mill Creek Fire.

**Description of Closed Areas:**

**Exemptions:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit issued by a forest officer specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**Penalty:** Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3359 and 3571).
