

Smoke Synopsis

The Bald Knob Fire has produced little smoke in the last few days. Small amounts of rain were received on portions of the fire Monday.

The Wolf Creek Fire continues to produce smoke by smoldering the leaves and ground fuels. The fire received light rain Monday afternoon. Expect the town of Old Fort will continue to see light smoke impact.

Dry weather is forecast for later in the week as the cold front passes through Tuesday causing an increase in smoke production.

Air Quality will remain in the **Green Level** for Tuesday and remain in the **Green Level** through Wednesday as rain moves through the region.
