



EMERGENCY AREA CLOSURE
DESCHUTES AND OCHOCO NATIONAL FORESTS
SISTERS RANGER DISTRICT AND CROOKED RIVER NATIONAL GRASSLAND

Pursuant to 16 USC, 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited within the area and on sections of National Forest system trails and roads within the Deschutes and Ochoco National Forests as described below, and as shown on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this order as Attachment 'A'.

Beginning at a point located at the intersection of Forest Roads 1170 and Jefferson County Road 64 (Montgomery Road) in Township 11 South, Range 11 East, Section 33; thence west along Forest Road 1170 to its intersection with Forest Road 11 in Township 11 South, Range 10 East, Section 2; thence south along Forest Road 11 to its intersection with Private Road 1129 in Township 12 South, Range 10 East, Section 34; thence south along Private Road 1129 to its intersection with Forest Road 1126 in Township 13 South, Range 10 East, Section 28; thence east along Forest Road 1126 to its intersection with Forest Road 2055 in Township 13 South, Range 10 East, Section 34; thence north along Forest Road 2055 to its intersection of the south boundary line of Township 12 South, Range 11 East, Section 7; thence east along the south boundary line of Township 12 South; Range 11 East, Section 7, 8, 9, and 10 to its intersection with Township 13 South, Range 11 East, Section 15, Taxlot 3200; thence south and west along the boundary of Taxlot 3200 to its intersection with Jefferson County Road 63 (Flat Road); thence north along Jefferson County Road 63 (Flat Road) to its intersection with Montgomery Road in Township 12 South, Range 12 East, Section 18; thence north and west along Montgomery Road back to the point of beginning.

PROHIBITIONS

It is prohibited to go into or be upon any of the above described lands which are closed for the protection of public health and safety, 36 CFR § 261.53(e) including all National Forest System roads and trails therein. 36 CFR § 261.53(e)

These restrictions are in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36CFR§261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR§261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Personnel with written authorization by a Forest Officer, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission. The issuing Officer may include such conditions as are considered necessary for the protection of the area, or for the promotion of the health, safety, or welfare of its users.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or volunteer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons or their invitees who live or own property within the closure area, and permittees who have a legitimate need to access their permitted allotment if escorted or approved by IMT.
4. Jefferson County Road 64 (Montgomery Road) is open to vehicle traffic.

This closure is enacted due to firefighting activities taking place within the closure area, and for the protection of public and employee safety. This order replaces ORDER NO.06-01-05-16-002, which is hereby rescinded.

This order becomes effective from the date and time signed, and will remain in force until rescinded.

VIOLATION OF THESE PROHIBITIONS IS PUNISHABLE AS A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR, BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000 FOR AN INDIVIDUAL OR \$10,000 FOR A LEGAL ENTITY OTHER THAN AN INDIVIDUAL, OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN SIX (6) MONTHS, OR BOTH. TITLE 16 USC, SECTION 551; TITLE 18 USC, SECTION 3551.
