

ORDER RSF-239

EMERGENCY CLOSURE - FIRE

ROGUE RIVER-SISKIYOU NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the High Cascades Ranger District, Rogue River-Siskiyou Forest, as described in this order and attached map (Exhibit A), to provide for public health and safety due to active fire and extreme fire conditions in the area until September 30th, 2014, or unless sooner rescinded.

Closure Area Boundary

1. Being within the described area for public health and safety [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

Following the exterior of the following section lines: T.33S, R.4E, Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30, and 31; T.34S, R.4E, Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 11, 14, 23, 25, and 26; T.34S, R5E, Sections 2, 11, 14, 23, 26, 27, 28, 29, and 30; T.33S, R5E, Sections 8, 17, 20, 26, 27, 28, and 35.

AND, that area south of the Middle Fork Rogue River in the following sections: T.33S, R5E Sections 7 and 8; T.33S, R4E, Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4; T.32S, R4E, Sections 31, 32, and 33.

The Forest closure area is shown on the attached map (Exhibit A).

Pursuant to 36 CFR Part 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the Order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This Order will become effective immediately.
