# ALAMO FIRE

April 21st 2008, 10:00 a.m.

### Location:

- Nogales Ranger District, Coronado National Forest
- 13 miles west of Nogales, Arizona

Fire Reported on: Friday, 4/18 8:47 am

Size: **5070** acres

Cause: Human caused

Percent Contained: **40%** with estimate for containment on April 24<sup>th</sup>.

Incident Management Assigned: Eastern AZ Incident Management Team, Pruett Small, Incident Commander.

### Resources Assigned:

- Firefighters: **278**
- Engines: **21**
- Air Tankers: **2 (on standby)**
- Helicopters: **3**

Closures: Forest Road 39 at the intersection of Forest Road 39A, Forest Road 289 (Ruby Road) at the Calabasas Campground, Pena Blanca Lake and Campground

Evacuations: Pena Blanca Campground

Structures Threatened: Two ranch properties    Destroyed: None

Fire Behavior: Active - Driven by strong afternoon winds

Fire Weather: Very dry with ridge top winds from the west at 20 mph, slope valley winds light and variable in the morning with gusts to 20 mph in the afternoon. Upslope winds are expected to be 5 to 8 mph.
