

ORDER NO. 07-10-5100-8
EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER
LOS PADRES NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to protect public safety and natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Los Padres National Forest. This order is effective from July 27, 2007, until the Zaca Fire is suppressed.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Zaca Fire Closure Area. The Zaca Fire Closure Area begins at the Los Padres National Forest boundary where the Sisquoc River exits the National Forest in Sec. 27, T9N, R30W, then following eastward and southeastward along the south side of the Sisquoc River in the San Rafael Wilderness to the intersection of the Sisquoc River and Big Pine Canyon in Sec.1, T7N, R26W, then following southward along the west side of Big Pine Canyon to its intersection with Forest Road No. 9N11 (Big Pine Mountain/Buckhorn Road), then following westward along the north edge of Big Pine Campground, then following southwestward along the north side of Forest Road No. 9N11 at the edge of the San Rafael Wilderness to its intersection with Forest Road No. 6N14, then following northwestward along the south side of Forest Road No. 6N14 to its intersection with the McKinley Fire Trail, then following northward along the west side then south side of the McKinley Fire Trail to Forest Road No. 8N08, then westward along the south side of Forest Road No. 8N08 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 8N09 (Sunset Valley Road) at Cachuma Saddle, then following westward along the south side of Forest Road No. 7N07 (Figueroa Mountain Road) to its intersection with the Los Padres National Forest boundary in Sec.27, T8N, R30W, then following northward along the Los Padres National Forest boundary to the point of beginning, as shown on the attached Zaca Fire Closure Area Map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Zaca Fire Closure Area. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National System trail within the Zaca Fire Closure Area. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of land in the Zaca Fire Closure Area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
4. Residents in the Zaca Fire Closure Area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their residences.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581. This order supercedes order number 07-08-5100-6 dated July 17, 2007.
