SPECIAL ORDER

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following act is prohibited on the area, road, or trail as described in this order, all within the Spanish Fork Ranger District, Uinta National Forest until further notice.

1. Being in the area described [36 CFR 261.53 (e)].

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

South Nebo area located within the following description including all interior roads and trails and shown on attached map: Beginning at the west Forest Boundary at the Mona Pole Road (FR 160), running east along the Mona Pole road to the Nebo Loop Road (FR 015), then east along Trails 106, 084, and 130 to the intersection of the Nebo Creek Road (FR 045), then east along the Nebo Creek Road to the Forest Boundary, then south along the Forest Boundary to the southeast corner of the Forest Boundary, then west along the Forest Boundary to the southwest corner of the Forest Boundary, then north to the intersection of the Mona Pole Road and the Forest Boundary. Mona Pole Road (FR 160) will remain open. Nebo Creek Road (FR 045), Nebo Loop Road (FR015) and trails 106, 084, and 130 will be closed.

PURPOSE:

Area is closed for public safety due to the Salt Creek Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
2. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months imprisonment. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7).

4. This Order supercedes an previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads or trails) covered by this Order.
