Angel Rocks Trail in Chena River State Recreation Area re-opens

(Fairbanks, AK) - Following moderate weather over the weekend fire danger from the West Fork Fire has diminished allowing Alaska State Parks to re-open Angel Rocks Trail and the North Fork public use cabin.

Closures continue on all trails and cabins north of the Chena Hot Springs Road in Chena River State Recreation Area. Campgrounds and all trails on the south side of the Chena Hot Springs Road, including recreational access to the Chena River, are open. Chena Hot Springs and local businesses also remain open.

People driving the Chena Hot Springs Road will see activity from crews and equipment supporting the firefighting effort. Please be alert and drive slowly if you will be in this area.
