

**ORDER**  
**CAMILLO FIRE CLOSURE**  
**COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST**  
Flagstaff and Mogollon Ranger Districts

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551, and 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Coconino National Forest, in Coconino County in the state of Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

**PROHIBITION:**

1. **Going into or being upon the restricted area; 36 CFR § 261.52(e)**
2. **Being on the road; 36 CFR § 261.54(e)**
3. **Being on a trail; 36 CFR § 261.55(a)**

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Officer or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Resident owners will be allowed to drive to and from their residence.

**AREA DESCRIPTION:**

The order applies to National Forest System lands, roads, and trails within the vicinity of the Little Mormon Mountain beginning at Forest Highway 3 east along FR 125 to FR 9720 /9494H south to FR 124D, the closure area includes forest land west of the High Voltage power line. The closure boundary continues east along FR124D to FR 124 over to FR 82 where the boundary proceeds south. The boundary then ties into FR 9724B and heads west to FR 6043. It then continues west across the high voltage lines along FR 92 to Forest Highway 3 which then continues north connecting back into FR 125. This closure includes Little Mormon Mountain trails,

Forest Roads heading south off FR 125 will be closed, however roads north of FR 125 will remain open along with FR 125 access to Kinnikinick Lake and Mint Springs areas.


**PURPOSE:**

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to the ongoing managed Camillo Fire.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until July 11<sup>th</sup> 2015 or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed in Exhibit A


