





AZNST Reroute Map 1






AZNST Reroute Map 2






AZNST Reroute Map 3






AZNST Reroute Map 5






AZNST Reroute Map 6





**ORDER
TEMPORARY CLOSURE
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST
MOGOLLON RIM RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System land within the Coconino National Forest, Mogollon Rim Ranger District, Coconino County, Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being in the restricted area; **36 CFR §261.53(e)**.
2. Being on any road in the restricted area; **36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e)**.
3. Being on any trail within the restricted area; **36 C.F.R § 261.55(a)**.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force or other authorized personnel in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The closure is bounded by Coconino Highway 3 and Forest Roads (FR): FR 135, FR 9361E, FR 9361P and FR 93A.

Coconino Highway 3, FR 135, FR 93 are open for public travel. The closure only applies to National Forest System lands and roads.

PURPOSE:

This Order is necessary for public health and safety due to fire activity in the restricted area for the management of the Mormon Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order becomes effective when signed and will remain in force until rescinded or until June 26, 2016, whichever event occurs first.

2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed in Exhibit A.
