### **Flying J Prescribed Fire Work Continues near Tusayan**


TUSAYAN, AZ – With the return of drier conditions, fire managers may burn 50 acres starting on Thursday November 7, 2013. Located on the north end of town west of Highway 64, the fire will be very visible from the town of Tusayan and directly adjacent properties such as the IMAX Theater.

Daytime smoke is predicted to disperse to the northwest with some daytime impact to the town of Tusayan. Overnight smoke will likely settle in the Long Jim Canyon area as well as Coconino Wash. All prescribed fire activity is dependent on personnel availability, weather – including winds and ventilation, and approval from the ADEQ ([www.azdeq.gov](http://www.azdeq.gov)).
