

ORDER
SUMMIT MOUNTAIN TRAIL #68 - FIRE CLOSURE
WILLIAMS RANGER DISTRICT
KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands administered by the Kaibab National Forest in Coconino County in the State of Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being on a trail, 36 CFR 261.55 (a).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and,
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

AREA DESCRIBED:

This order affects Kaibab National Forest Trail #68, the Summit Mountain Trail, for its entire length of 1.1 miles on the Kaibab National Forest, Williams Ranger District, within Township 20 North, Range 2 East, Section 12.

PURPOSE:

This order is needed for public safety.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until September 30, 2015, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.


