Cooperating Agencies: BNSF Railway, Union Pacific Railway, Cal Trans, Southern California Edison, LA DWP, American Red Cross, San Bernardino Animal Control, CHP.

Fire Status: Firefighters continue to make progress containing the fire while maintaining a high degree of mindfulness about minimizing their personal risk. The vegetation is so dry that there is a 100% chance that a single ember will ignite a fire. Despite these conditions firefighters have made progress containing the fire. The fire is burning most actively on the western and northern sides of the fire.

Total Personnel: 1584

Closure Update:

- Santa Fe/Summit Valley Road and Arrowhead Lake Road/Hwy 173 are open
- Highway 138 remains closed at I-15 east to Summit Valley Road
- I-15 Cleghorn exists are closed. Also Highway 138 exit is closed.
- Southbound I-15 from Main Street in Hesperia to I-215 in San Bernardino is open
- State Route 2 is closed from the Los Angeles County Line to State Route-138
- State Route 138 is closed from the Los Angeles County Line to State Route-173
- Closed- Glen Helen at Sierra
- Closed – Cajon at Devore - residents only. Closed Kenwood at Cajon.
