Update August 21th, 2016, 7:00 a.m.

Location: Devore, California

Date and Time of Fire Start: August 16, 2016, 10:44 a.m.

Cause: Under Investigation

Size: 37,020 acres **Containment:** 83 percent

Management: California Interagency Incident Management Team 4

Cooperating Agencies: BNSF Railway, Union Pacific Railway, Cal Trans, Southern California Edison, LA DWP, American Red Cross, San Bernardino Animal Control, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and the California Highway Patrol

Fire Status: Today mop up efforts will continue, as well as continued construction of containment lines in an effort to move toward repopulation of the remaining evacuated areas. Utility companies will continue to work in the fire area to replace damaged and destroyed infrastructure. The Damage Assessment Team has confirmed that the fire destroyed 105 single family homes and 213 other minor structures.
