

SAN BERNARDINO NATIONAL FOREST
Forest Order No. 05-12-00-20-12
Apple Fire Emergency Closure

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited on the San Bernardino National Forest. This Order is effective from August 2, 2020, through September 1, 2020.

1. Being on the National Forest System roads listed below.

- a. Forest Road 1S03 (Falls Road).
- b. Forest Road 1S03A (Falls Picnic Area Road).
- c. Forest Road 1S03C (Vivian Trailhead Road)
- d. Forest Road 1S03D
- e. Forest Road 1S42 (Momyer Parking Road)
- f. Forest Road 1N53 (Camp Angelus Road)
- g. Forest Road 1N82 (Forsee Ridge Road)

2. Being on the National Forest System trails listed below.

- a. Forest Trail No. 1E04
- b. Forest Trail No. 1E06
- c. Forest Trail No. 1E08
- d. Forest Trail No. 1E09
- e. Forest Trail No. 1E13
- f. Forest Trail No. 2E05
- g. Forest Trail No. 1W07
- h. Trail No. 2000 (Pacific Crest Trail) from the San Bernardino National Forest boundary in southeast corner of Section 31, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, San Bernardino Baseline and Meridian continuing north to its intersection with Forest Road 1N01 in Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, San Bernardino Baseline and Meridian.

3. Entering or being in the San Gorgonio Wilderness. 36 C.F.R. 261.57(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.

2. Any federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
