
Smoke Advisories remain in place for portions of the South Coast Air Quality Management District and the Mojave Desert Air Quality Management District. Please see the links below for more information.

**Fires**

Two fires are burning in the forecast area: The Bobcat, (113,986 55% containment) and the El Dorado (22,604 acres, 81% containment). Yesterday, both fires burned interior with very little to no growth. Evacuation orders have been lifted for the communities of Angelus Oaks and Seven Oaks while evacuation orders remain in place for the Bobcat Fire. see link below for Inciweb for more information

**Smoke:**

Today, light winds will follow typical diurnal patterns through Saturday- westerly winds through late morning and afternoon hours will effect communities east of the Bobcat and El Dorado Fires. Communities west of the fires will experience smoke due to easterly and downslope winds.
