
Smoke Advisories remain in place for portions of the South Coast Air Quality Management District and the Mojave Desert Air Quality Management District. Please see the links below for more information.

Fires

Two fires are burning in the forecast area: The Bobcat, (114,103 65% containment) and the El Dorado (22,666 acres, 92% containment). Yesterday, both fires burned interior with very little to no growth. Today and tomorrow the approaching high pressure will shift wind direction from the east, bringing gusty winds, and hot, very dry conditions to the fire areas. High potential for igniting unburnt dry fuels. Red Flag Warning in effect from 8 pm tonight thru 5 pm Monday. See link below for Inciweb for more information

Smoke:

Today and tonight, east winds will increase speed as the high pressure moves into the area. Today, smoke from fires burning inside the perimeter will disperse with light winds up and downslope until the east winds pick up speed later tonight. Expect strong wind gusts on the ridges from the E-NE up to 35 mph or higher in some exposed areas, transporting smoke to the west and southwest of the fires. Smoke from fires north of the LA Basin may produce haze and additional smoke into the LA Basin and desert communities tomorrow.
