ROGUE RIVER-SISKIYOU NATIONAL FOREST

FOREST ORDER RSF-188

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District as described in Exhibit A - Area Map, until October 15, 2012, unless sooner rescinded. This order is to provide for public health and safety due to active fire in the area.


- I) Being on Forest Service Road 1040, on the Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District, starting at the Oregon/California state border, T. 48 N., R. 11 W., Sec. 17 and continuing west to the Oregon/California state border, T. 48 N., R. 12 W., Sec. 18. [36 CFR 261.54(e)]
- II) Being on Forest Service Trail #959, Cook and Green, starting at T. 48 N., R. 11 Sec. 30 and continuing south to Cook and Green Pass at the Rogue River-Siskiyou and Klamath National Forest Boundaries, T. 47 N., R. 11 W., Sec. 8. [36 CFR 261.55(a)]
- III) Being on Forest Service Trail #958, Horse Camp, starting at T. 48 N., R. 11 W., Sec. 30 and continuing south to the Rogue River-Siskiyou and Klamath National Forest Boundaries, T. 47 N., R. 11 W., Sec. 7.
- IV) Being on Forest Service Trail #957, Butte Forks, starting at the junction of Forest Trail #958, Horse Camp, T. 48 N., R. 11 W., Section 31 and continuing west to Azalea Lake, T. 18 N., R. 8 E., Sec 9 (Humboldt Meridian). [36 CFR 261.55(a)]
- V) Being on Forest Service Trail #954 Shoofly, starting at T. 48 N., R. 12 W., Sec. 35, continuing south to Forest Service Trail #957, Butte Fork, T. 48 N., R. 12 W., Sec. 35. [36 CFR 261.55(a)]

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- I) Any Federal, State, or local Officer of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- II) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Done at Medford, Oregon this 18th day of August 2012, effective immediately.

Violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both, Title 16, U.S.C., Section 551 and USC 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
