

ORDER NO. 14-05-748
KLAMATH NATIONAL FOREST
EMERGENCY CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Klamath National Forest. This Order is effective from August 13, 2014, until the Whites Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Whites Fire Closure Area. The boundary of the Whites Fire Closure Area begins at the intersection of the National Forest boundary and the Shelly Fork Trail (Forest Trail No. 5527); then continues westerly along the Shelly Fork Trail (Forest Trail No. 5527) to its intersection with the Right Hand Fork Trail (Forest Trail No. 5401); then continues westerly along the Right Hand Fork Trail (Forest Trail No. 5401) to its intersection with the Bug Gulch Trail (Forest Trail No. 5403); then continues westerly along the Bug Gulch Trail (Forest Trail No. 5403) to its intersection with Upper Abbotts Trail (Forest Trail No. 5402); then continues southerly along Upper Abbotts Trail (Forest Trail No. 5402) to its intersection with North Fork Salmon Trail (Forest Trail No. 5405); then continues southwesterly along the North Fork Salmon Trail (Forest Trail No. 5405) to its intersection with the Snowslide Trail (Forest Trail No. 5427); then continues southerly along the Snowslide Trail (Forest Trail No. 5427) to its intersection with the Old Snowslide Trail (Forest Trail No. 5433); the continues southeasterly along Old Snowslide Trail (Forest Trail No. 5433) to its intersection with the Little North Fork Trail (Forest Trail No. 5406), then continues southeasterly along the Little North Fork Trail (Forest Trail No. 5406) to its intersection with Forest Road No. 40N51; then continues southerly along Forest Road No. 40N51 to its intersection with Sawyers Bar Road (County Road No. 1C01); then continues easterly along the northern edge of Sawyers Bar Road (County Road No. 1C01) to its intersection with Shiltos Creek; then continues southerly along Shiltos Creek to its intersection with Orin E. Lewis Road (Forest Road No. 39N27); then continues easterly along Orin E. Lewis Road (Forest Road No. 39N27) to its intersection with Blue Ridge Tie Road (Forest Road No. 39N41); then continues southerly along Blue Ridge Tie Road (Forest Road No. 39N41) to its intersection with Grasshopper Picayune Road (Forest Road No. 39); then continues westerly along Grasshopper Picayune Road (Forest Road No. 39) to its intersection with Shadow Creek Road (Forest Road No. 39N20); then continues southerly along Shadow Creek Road (Forest Road No. 39N20) to its intersection with Cecilville Road (County Road No. 1C02); then continues easterly along the northern edge of Cecilville Road (County Road No. 1C02) to its intersection with the Camp Eden Road (Forest Road No. 41N14), then continues northerly along Camp Eden Road (Forest Road No. 41N14) to the National Forest boundary, then continues northerly along the National Forest boundary back to the starting point. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being upon any National Forest System road in the Whites Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being upon any National Forest System trail in the Whites Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.



