**** Evacuation Advisory Order Due to Happy Camp Complex Fires ****

Due to the growth the Happy Camp Complex fires Effective 10:00 AM, August 13th 2014, an Evacuation Advisory is being issued by the Siskiyou County Sheriff's Office for residents of Happy Camp, at the request of the Happy Camp Fire Incident Commander. This notice is for all residents along China grade Road from Elk Creek Road to Frying Pan Creek. Residents should be prepared to evacuate should fire conditions worsen.

During an evacuation advisory you should begin preparing for a potential evacuation order. Individuals requiring more time to evacuate should consider leaving now. You should also consider removing large animals and large personal items such as motor homes, boats, and heavy equipment.

An evacuation center has been established by the Red Cross at Scott Valley Jr High School, located at 237 Butte Street, Ft Jones. For further information regarding domestic pets, please contact Jodi Aceves at 530-340-2422.
