**Due to increased fire activity of the Happy Camp Complex the following evacuation orders are currently in effect:**

Mandatory Evacuation orders are in effect for the below areas. If you are in area that is under mandatory evacuation please be aware that you may not be able to reenter the evacuation area until the fire danger has passed. The Siskiyou County Sheriff's Department will be patrolling 24 hours in the evacuated areas. At this time we do not know how long the evacuations will last, as soon as it is safe for residents to return to their homes notices will be given.

***-Scott River Road from Bridge Flat to the intersection of Hwy. 96***

***-All areas south of Hwy. 96 between Scott River Road and Grider Creek***

***-All areas south of Hwy. 96 from Seiad Valley down river to Cade Summit***

Advisory Evacuations are in effect for the areas listed below. During an evacuation advisory you should begin preparing for a potential evacuation order. Individuals requiring more time to evacuate should consider leaving now. You should also consider removing large animals and large personal items such as motor homes, boats, and heavy equipment. When under an advisory evacuation please be prepared to evacuate on short notice as fire conditions can change rapidly.

***-All areas north of Hwy. 96 between Scott River Road and Grider Creek***

A shelter has been established by the Office of Emergency Services, at Winema Hall, Siskiyou County Fairgrounds, Yreka. Domestic pets will be allowed at the shelter. If you are in need of assistance with livestock please contact Sheriff's Dispatch at 841-2900.
