**** Evacuation Advisory Order Due to Happy Camp Complex Fires ****

Due to increased fire activity of the Happy Camp Complex the northeast, the Siskiyou County Sheriff is issuing Advisory Evacuations to residents in all areas of Mill Creek Road 5 miles east of Scott River Rd. Residents should be prepared to evacuate should fire conditions worsen.

During an evacuation advisory you should begin preparing for a potential evacuation order. Individuals requiring more time to evacuate should consider leaving now. You should also consider removing large animals and large personal items such as motor homes, boats, and heavy equipment.

An evacuation center has been established at Happy Camp Karuk Tribal Community Center, 2nd Ave. and Headway Rd, Happy Camp CA. Small animals will be accommodated at the Center. Large animal transport can be arranged through the Sheriff's Posse. Contact Jodi Aceves, (530) 340-2422 to arrange transport.
