### **\*\*Mandatory Evacuation Due to Happy Camp Complex Fires \*\***

Effective 12:00 p.m., September 10, 2014, the Siskiyou County Sheriff's Office is issuing a Mandatory Evacuation for residents of Kelsey Creek Road from Scott River Road. This is including Parts of Boulder Creek Rd. to the North West towards Kelsey Creek. Forest Service Roads 44N24, and any other side roads not listed here Once you leave, you may not be able to reenter the evacuation area until the fire danger has passed.

Residents of Indian Scotty Campground Rd and East of Boulder Creek who are in the evacuation advisory area west of Indian Scotty will be issued an entry pass to access their homes. Please remain vigilant and monitor official sources for updated fire information.

Two evacuation centers have been established at Happy Camp Karuk Tribal Community Center, Headway Rd, Happy Camp CA and the Siskiyou County Fairgrounds at 1712 Fairlane Road, Yreka. Both large and small animals will be accommodated at both evacuation centers. Large animal transport can be arranged through the Sheriff's Posse.
