**** Happy Camp Complex Fire Mandatory Evacuation Changed to Advisory ****

The Siskiyou County Sheriff Office has changed the Mandatory Evacuations to Advisory Evacuations in the following areas on Scott River Road. The area between Scott Bar Post Office at 27233 Scott River Road to Mile Marker 25 on Scott River Road is now an advisory evacuation area. For address orientation, this includes 24932 Scott River Road. Residents in this area are asked to access their homes via highway 96. The area between Mile Marker 25 on the Scott River Road to Canyon Creek Road continues to remain under a mandatory evacuation order. Please be aware of Firefighters and equipment still working in this area.

During an evacuation advisory you should begin preparing for a potential evacuation order. Individuals requiring more time to evacuate should consider leaving now. You should also consider removing large animals and large personal items such as motor homes, boats, and heavy equipment.

An evacuation center has been established at Happy Camp Karuk Tribal Community Center, 529 Jacobs Way, Happy Camp CA. Small animals will be accommodated at the Center. Large animal transport can be arranged through the Sheriff's Posse. Contact Jodi Aceves, (530) 340-2422 to arrange transport.
