## Happy Camp Complex Morning Update Sunday, September 14, 2014

**Date Started:** August 11, 2014

**Size of the complex:** 111,942 acres

**Containment for the complex:** 55 percent

**Estimated Containment Date:** September 20, 2014

**Structures Damaged or Destroyed:** 8

**Total Personnel:** 1,864

**Resources:** 50 crews, 13 helicopters, 65 engines, 18 dozers, 38 water tenders

**Two community meetings are planned** to provide the public with current information on Happy Camp Complex current fire suppression efforts. **A Seiad Valley community meeting will be held today**, September 14, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the Seiad Valley Fire Station, 44601 Hwy 96, Seiad Valley, CA. **A Fort Jones community meeting will be held Monday**, September 15, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at Fort Jones City Hall/Community Center, 11960 East Street, Fort Jones, CA.

**Weather and Fire Behavior:** Yesterday the fire grew an estimated 1,470 acres on the southernmost edge. This portion of the fire will be active today in the Marble Mountain Wilderness, moving south toward the Man Fire. Skies will be mostly clear with smoke trapped in the valleys. Winds from the south at 4-7 mph will become southwesterly at 7-12 mph in the afternoon.

**Operations:** Today, firefighters and engines will continue to patrol around structures on Scott River Road and watch for material that might roll onto the road. Most of the fire is in patrol, mop-up and suppression repair status. On the southernmost portion, work continues to strengthen the control line along Big Ridge between King's Castle and Black Marble Mountain to prevent fire from moving eastward. Demobilization of firefighters and equipment will continue as containment progresses. Firefighters have completed suppression repair on 28 miles of hand and dozer firelines.

**Evacuations and Road Closures:** There is a mandatory evacuation for Scott Valley Road between milepost 25 and Indian Scotty Campground.
