Happy Camp Complex Daily Update

A community meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. Friday, September 26 at the Ft. Jones City Hall/Community Center, 11960 East Street, Fort Jones, CA. Representatives from California Interagency Incident Management Team 4 and the Klamath National Forest will provide an update on the Happy Camp Complex and be available to answer questions.

Current Information:

Rain fell over the entire fire area yesterday, with some areas receiving up to two inches. Rain showers are forecasted through this afternoon. Minimal fire activity is expected, but areas in the fire's interior where large, heavy fuels exist have potential to retain heat, and isolated smokes may continue to be visible in coming days.

Incident personnel will assess the fire area today to determine the condition of roads and check for fallen trees and debris flows that may have been caused by the storm. Resources assigned to the fire will be available to assist with re-opening roads if necessary. Due to the fire's current containment status, the completion of fire suppression repair work, and the effect of the rain on the fire, most of the fire crews and engines have been demobilized from the Happy Camp Complex.

A Burned Area Emergency Response (BAER) team is working with the Klamath National Forest on a plan for repair of the lands directly impacted by the fire. For more information on the BAER program, please see http://www.nifc.gov/BAER/Page/NIFC_BAER.html.
