ROGUE RIVER-SISKIYOU NATIONAL FOREST
ORDER NO. 06-10-0020-16-23
EMERGENCY CLOSURE

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within Oak Knoll District of the Klamath National Forest and the Siskiyou Mountains District of the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest. This Order is effective from September 14, 2016, until the Gap Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Gap Fire Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map, 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Gap Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map, 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Gap Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map, 36 CFR 261.55(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(c), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both, 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.



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Exhibit A

The Gap Fire Closure Area boundary begins at the intersection of Highway 96 and the Seiad Creek Road (County Road No. SIS-8D002); then continues northeasterly along the southeastern edge of the Seiad Creek Road (County Road No. SIS-8D002) to its intersection with the Horse Creek Road (Forest Road No. 46N50); then continues northeasterly along the southeastern edge of the Horse Creek Road (Forest Road No. 46N50) to its intersection with the West Horse Road (Forest Road No. 47N70); then continues northerly then easterly then northeasterly then northwesterly along the eastern edge of West Horse Road (Forest Road No. 47N70) to its intersection with southern edge of Section 14 of Township 47 North, Range 11 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian (MDBM); then continues west along the southern boundary of Section 14 to its intersection with the southwest corner of Section 14; then continues northerly along the section line to its intersection with the Pacific Crest Trail (Forest Trail No. 2000); then continues easterly along the southern edge of the Pacific Crest Trail (Forest Trail No. 2000) to its intersection with the Siskiyou Summit Road (Forest Road No. 40S01); then continues southeasterly along the southwestern edge of the Siskiyou Summit Road (Forest Road No. 40S01) to its intersection with northern boundary of Section 30 of Township 47 North, Range 9 West, MDBM;

then continues west along the northern boundary of Section 30 to its intersection with the northwestern corner of Section 30; then continues south along the western boundary of Section 30 to the intersection with the southwestern corner of Section 30; then continues east along the south boundary of Section 30 to its intersection with Kohl Creek; then continues southerly along the western boundary of Kohl Creek to its intersection with Highway 96; then continues westerly along the northern boundary of Highway 96 back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
