CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Today crews observed erratic winds following column collapse and are reporting 300 ft. flame lengths in some of the southeast areas of the Ranch Fire. Crews were working hard to protect property in the Lucerne with many fire personnel mobilized to that area. The River Fire we had some successful burn operations on the northeast side and continue to make good progress.
