Final News Release Unless Significant Changes Occur with the Bagley Fire

****New Fire Information Number (530) 275-1587****

The Bagley Fire is 100% contained. About 130 firefighters and other support personnel will remain on the fire to patrol the perimeter and ensure the fire remains within its established containment lines. Crews will also continue with suppression and road repair within the perimeter of the fire.

Forest Roads remain closed under Forest Service Order 14-12-02. The closure impacts several roads including:

- Fenders Ferry Road (34N17) at Reynolds Basin Road (35N46) leading to the Madrone Campground.
- Starting at the McCloud Bridge, Fenders Ferry Road (34N17) and Forest Road 35N56 and leading to Madrone Campground.
- Lower Squaw Valley Road (39N21) at Squaw Valley Road (Forest Route 11)

Fire officials would like to advise visitors and recreationalists using the Hawkins Landing Campground and Boat Ramp that these are the **ONLY** areas re-opened under Amendment 2 of the Bagley Fire Emergency Closure Order No. 14-12-02. This amendment allows public access to part of the Bagley Fire Emergency Closure Area.

This closure is being implemented to protect public and firefighter safety during the Bagley Fire Incident on the Shasta-Trinity National forest. The area will be closed to ensure that the public does not enter into an area that might be threatened by fire or where suppression rehabilitation efforts may be ongoing. The roads will be closed due to hazardous conditions, such as low visibility, dust, narrow and windy road conditions and increased fire operations traffic. These closures will remain in place until the area is safe for the public. Please see the Forest Orders and closure maps on InciWeb.

Transfer of command from the South Central Sierra Interagency Incident Management Team back to the Shasta-Trinity National Forest took place this morning at 6:00 AM.
