

ORDER NO. 14-15-05  
FIRE CLOSURE  
SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This Order is effective from August 18, 2015, until the order is rescinded.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Fork, South, Route, and Mad River Complex Fire Closure Areas on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest described below and shown on Exhibit A.
  - a. Route and South Complex Fire Closure Areas - The boundary of the Route and South Complex Fire Closure Areas on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest begins at the intersection of the Six Rivers National Forest/Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary and the Hayfork Ranger District boundary of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest (Township 4 North, Range 6 East, Section 15, Humboldt Meridian), then continues southwest along the Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary to its intersection with Forest Road No. 6N01 (Township 3 North, Range 6 East, Section 11, Humboldt Meridian), then continues southeast along the Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary to its intersection with Forest Road No. 4N12 (South Fork Mountain Road) (Township 2 North, Range 6 East, Section 21, Humboldt Meridian), then continues southeast along Forest Road No. 4N12 to its intersection with Sulpher Glade Creek (Township 1 North, Range 6 East, Section 3, Humboldt Meridian), then continues northeast along Sulpher Glade Creek to its intersection with French Ranch (Township 2 North, Range 6 East, Section 25, Humboldt Meridian), then continues due east through Township 2 North, Range 7 East, Section 30 and Section 29 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 2N16 (Limedye Lookout Road) (Township 2 North, Range 7 East, Section 29, Humboldt Meridian), then continues north along Forest Road No. 2N16 to its intersection with County Road No. 316 (St. John Road), then continues north along County Road No. 316 to its intersection with County Road No. 301 (Hyampom Road), then continues east along County Road No. 301 to the intersection with Forest Trail No. 12W23 (Township 3 North, Range 8 East, Section 20, Humboldt Meridian), then continues northeast along Forest Trail No. 12W23 to its intersection with Forest Trail No. 12W31 (Township 3 North, Range 8 East, Section 16, Humboldt Meridian), then continues northeast along Forest Trail No. 12W31 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 4N29 (Township 33 North, Range 12 West, Section 30, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues east and then north along Forest Road No. 4N29 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 4N16 (Township 4 North, Range 8 East, Section 21, Humboldt Meridian), then continues north along Forest Road No. 4N16 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 4N47 (Township 4 North, Range 8 East, Section 21, Humboldt Meridian), then continues west along Forest Road No. 4N47 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 5N60 (Township 4 North, Range 7 East, Section 17, Humboldt Meridian), then continues northwest along Forest Road No. 5N60 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 4N41 (Township 4 North, Range 7 East, Section 17, Humboldt Meridian), then continues northeast along Forest Road No. 4N41

to its intersection with Forest Road No. 4N11 (Township 4 North, Range 7 East, Section 9, Humboldt Meridian), then continues due north through Township 4 North, Range 7 East, Sections 9 and 4 and Township 5 North, Range 7 East, Sections 33 and 28, Humboldt Meridian to Rowdy Bar Creek (Township 5 North, Range 7 East, Section 28, Humboldt Meridian), then continues due west through Township 5 North, Range 7 East, Sections 28, 29, 30 and Township 5 North, Range 6 East, Sections 25, 26, 27, and 28, Humboldt Meridian to the Six Rivers/Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary (Township 5 North, Range 6 East, Section 28, Humboldt Meridian), then continues southeast along the Six Rivers/Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary back to the starting point.

- b. Mad River Complex Fire Closure Area - The boundary of the Mad River Complex Fire Closure Area on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest begins at the intersection of State Highway 36 and Forest Road No. 29N58 (Rattlesnake Ridge Road) (Township 1 South, Range 8 East, Section 19, Humboldt Meridian), then continues west along Highway 36 to its intersection with the Six Rivers/Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary (Township 1 South, Range 7 East, Section 7, Humboldt Meridian), then continues southeast along the Six Rivers/Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary to its intersection with Forest Trail No. 8E01 (Township 2 South, Range 8 East, Section 6, Humboldt Meridian), then continues due east through Township 2 South, Range 8 East, Sections 6, 5, and 4, Humboldt Meridian and Township 29 North, Range 12 West, Section 31, Mount Diablo Meridian to its intersection with Forest Trail No. 8E18 (South Fork Trinity River Trail) (Township 29 North, Range 12 West, Section 31, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues northwest along the Forest Trail No. 8E18 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 1S25 (Scott Flat road) (Township 1 South, Range 8 East, Section 20, Humboldt Meridian), then continues north along the Forest Road No. 1S25 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 29N58 (Rattlesnake Ridge Road) (Township 1 South, Range 8 East, Section 19, Humboldt Meridian), then continues north along Forest Road No. 29N58 back to the starting point.
- c. Fork Complex Fire Closure Area - The boundary of the Fork Complex Fire Closure Area begins on Forest Road No. 33N47 (Soldier Creek Road) at its intersection with the section line for Section 25 and 30 (Township 33 North, Range 11 West, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southwest along Forest Road No. 33N47 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 33N84 (Township 33 North, Range 11 West, Section 28, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southwest along Forest Road No. 33N84 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 32N03 (Township 32 North, Range 11 West, Section 21, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southeast along Forest Road No. 32N03 to its intersection with the Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary (Township 32 North, Range 11 West, Section 28, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southeast and then south and then southwest and then west along the Forest boundary to its intersection with Tule Creek (Township 31 North, Range 12 West, Section 21, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southwest along Tule Creek to its intersection with Forest Road No. 31N31 (Township 31 North, Range 12 West, Section 29, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southwest along Forest Road No. 31N31 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 2N07 (Township 1 North, Range 8 East, Section 21, Humboldt Meridian), then continues southeast along Forest Road No. 2N07 to its intersection with Forest Road No.

30N59 (Township 30 North, Range 12 West, Section 28, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southwest along Forest Road No. 30N59 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 30N30 (Township 30 North, Range 12 West, Section 5, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southwest then east along Forest Road No. 30N30 to its intersection with State Highway 36 (Township 29 North, Range 12 West, Section 4, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues east along State Highway 36 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 29N73 (Red Mountain Motorway) (Township 29 North, Range 12 West, Section 4, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues southeast along Forest Road No. 29N73 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 29N55 and the Hayfork Ranger District boundary (Township 29 North, Range 12 West, Section 13, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues northeast along the Hayfork District boundary to its intersection with South Dubakella Mountain (Township 29 North, Range 11 West, Section 7, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues due north through Township 29 North, Range 11 West, Sections 7 and 6 and Township 30 North, Range 11 West, Section 31, Mount Diablo Meridian to its intersection with State Highway 36 (Township 30 North, Range 11 West, Section 31, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues east along Highway 36 to its intersection with Browns Creek Road (Forest Road No. 30N01) (Township 29 North, Range 10 West, Section 8, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues northeast along Browns Creek Road to its intersection with Browns Creek (Township 30 North, Range 9 West, Section 7, Mount Diablo Meridian), and then continues northeast up Corral Gulch along Forest Trail No. 9W25 to its intersection with the Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary (Township 30 North, Range 9 West, Section 6, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues north along the Forest boundary to the section line dividing Section 18 and Section 19 (Township 31 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Meridian), then continues east along Section 18 to its intersection with the Shasta-Trinity National Forest boundary, then continues northwest along the Forest boundary to its intersection with the southeast corner of Township 33 North, Range 11 West, Section 36, Mount Diablo Meridian, then continues north along the eastern section lines of Section 36 and Section 25 (Township 33 North, Range 11 West, Mount Diablo Meridian) back to the starting point.


2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Fork, South, Route, and Mad River Complex Fire Closure Areas on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Fork, South, Route, and Mad River Complex Fire Closure Areas on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. Violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.


