Fork Complex Morning Update

Sunday, August 23, 2015

Date Started: July 30, 2015 **Cause:** Lightning **Size:** 36,499 acres **Containment:** 78%

Current Fire Situation:

Most of the Fork Complex continues to be quiet, with fire activity concentrated in the Chanchelulla Wilderness area.

Today, aircraft will continue to make water drops on the east side of the Shiehl Fire in the Chanchelulla Wilderness. Additional containment lines are being constructed to contain the Fire within the Wilderness using Minimum Impact Suppression Tactics (MIST). Suppression repair has begun for the Barker and Blue fires.

Crews will continue to patrol and mop up along containment lines.

As many evacuations and road closures end, people returning to these areas are urged to be cautious. There is still a lot of fire equipment on roadways and there may be rocks and other hazards on the roads.
