



# River Complex Update

August 3, 0800 a.m.

Fire Information: (530) 276-8559

**Current Situation:** The fires of the River Complex continue to grow and burn together. The Happy and Dyer Fires have now combined and been named the Happy Fire.

Smoke from fires to the south is shading the area, moderating fire behavior. Fire runs have been driven by topography. Primarily, the fires have been backing down slope, burning only the vegetation on the ground. Falling dead trees in the area are presenting a hazard to firefighters on and off the roadways.

Firefighters are clearing vegetation structures and along roadways in the Dailey, Hoboken and Bell Flat area. Additionally, they are assessing the fires in the Trinity Alps Wilderness and formulating a plan to attack them.

With the large number of fires throughout Trinity County large amounts of smoke may be present. For air quality information see [www.airnow.gov](http://www.airnow.gov) ,

Motorists are urged to use caution when driving in the area due to impaired visibility due to smoke and fire equipment on the roadway.
